Dr Firdos Anwar is a Historian of Medieval Indian History. He retired as Associate Professor of History from Kirorimal College, University of Delhi with over 40 years of teaching experience to various undergraduate and post-graduate students. He did his graduation and Masters from Aligarh Muslim University and acquired his Ph. D from University of Delhi. He has several publications to his credit the most iconic being Nobility Under the Mughals (1628 – 58) published by Manohar Publications.

He was given Distinguished Teachers Award of University of Delhi in 2009, Excellence in Teaching Award by Kirori Mal College, DAAD Stipendant at South Asia Institute of Heidelberg University, Germany, Aligarh Muslim University Medal for standing first in M A History and Begum Khurshid Nurul Memorial Hasan Memorial Gold Medal for standing first in B A (Hons.) History.

Being an expert on medieval Indian history, Dr Firdos has keenly observed and evaluated the built heritages of Delhi especially those of the Mughal era as well as lesser-known monuments of Delhi. He is life member of Indian History Congress and he recently completed the vetting of the Hindi translation of ShahjahanNamah of Mohd. SalihKamboh.
