Niraj Kumar Singh is Associate Professor of History at Maharaja Agrasen College, University of Delhi for over 23 years. He is post-graduate in History with specialization in Modern India from University of Delhi. He completed his M Phil. from Department of History, University of Delhi and Ph. D in Ecological History titled "Imperial Politics of Forest Management: Chhotanagpur during the Colonial Rule – 1858 – 1947 from Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak in 2005. His major areas of interest are Cultural Transformation in Early Modern Europe, Modern Indian History, Urban History and Indian Art because of which he has acquired better understanding of the socio-cultural milieu of areas under study.
